2. ROUTE DESCRIPTION

The rally will be run on public roads of the Tartu, Valga and Põlva counties on 16.-18. July 2010 with the start and finish of the event being located in the town of Otepää.

Detailed route, timetable and time controls (TC) will be published in the Road Book.

2.2. Prohibited regions

Drivers, entrants and their representatives are strictly forbidden to visit the territories of Kambja, Valgjärve, Kõlleste, Kanepi, Otepää, Palupera, Karula, Urvaste and Taheva Districts in Valga, Põlva, Tartu and Võru Counties on the roads chosen to be Special Stages of the rally before 8.00 on 15th July 2010.

3. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- **3.1.** Retired crews are allowed to restart from the beginning of next Day. A crew which has failed to complete a Day will be assumed to re-start the rally from the start of the next Day unless they confirm otherwise with the clerk of the course by completion of the form located in the rear of the time card and lodging it with the organiser as soon as possible before the publishing of the start list for the next Day.
- **3.1.1.** For all crews which restart a time penalty will be applied as follows:

For every stage missed: 5 minutes. This time penalty will be added to the fastest time of the drivers' class.

Should retirement occur after the last special stage of a Day, the 5-minutes time penalty will be added.

- **3.1.2.** For the restarting, the cars must be presented to the Scrutineers at least 2 hours before the time of the start of the next Day. Cars are allowed to re-start after getting a permission from Clerk of the Course, Chief Scrutineer and Chief Medical Officer.
- 3.2. During the rally the maximum time of SS allowed by Estonian National Rally Regulations is used.

4. ENTRIES, SCRUTINEERING

4.1. Classes of cars

class Historic 69 – cars homologated before 31.12.1969

class Historic 75 – cars homologated before 31.12.1975

class Historic 81 – cars homologated before 31.12.1981

Eligible vehicles are those listed in article 2 of the "FIA European Historic Sporting Rally Championship" regulations.

- **4.2**. The entry form must be completed at www.autosport.ee/rallyreg. The form will be signed by the crew when receiving reconnaissance documents.
- 4.2.1. The maximum number of cars allowed to start will be 20.
- 4.2.2. Details concerning the co-driver may be presented or specified until 14.00 on July 16 (end of Scrutineering).
- 4.3. Pre-start Scrutineering
- 4.3.1. Pre-start Scrutineering 14.07 at 18:00-22:00 (with advanced notice/without schedule)

4.3.2. Pre-start Scrutineering on 15.07 according to the following timetable:

Marking of turbos will take place according to the Scrutineering timetable

No other vehicle other than the competition car is permitted to enter the Scrutineering area.

Any breach of the Scrutineering schedule may be subject to a cash penalty of 1000 EEK or start refusal.

4.3.1. The following valid documents must be presented at the Scrutineering: traffic insurance or Green Card, vehicle's passport, owner's authorisation for the use of the rally car on the name of the first driver, ASN technical card(Historic car passport), homologation books with extensions for cars of groups A and N (or clearly readable copies), equipment for drivers (helmets, outfits, underwear etc.) Competitors don't have to be present in the Scrutineering.

5. ENTRY FEES

5.1. Entry fees are as follows:

Details of payment: Name of the rally, entry fee, name of competitor, class.

The competitors have to present the payment order when collecting recce materials.

5.1.2. Competitors who have not paid the entry fee will be refused to start.

5.1.3. Refunding of Entry Fees

Entry Fee will be refunded if:

- a) to applicants whose entry has not been accepted
- b) in case of the rally not taking place in circumstances not depending on organizers, refund 50%.
- c) organizers may refund 50 % of the entry fee to those unable to start due to force major, duly certified by parent ASN, and announces about it before 09.07.2010.

6. INSURANCE

- **6.1.** All competition cars must hold valid traffic insurance or Green Card, covering liabilities towards third party. Estonian Traffic Law is binding throughout the event(except on Valka's part, where Latvian Traffic Law is binding).
- 6.2. EASU visa includes liability insurance towards third parties on Special Stages up to 4.000.000.

- **7. 2.** When collecting recce materials, the competitors have to present the following documents and information: valid drivers' licences, competitor licences, details of the recce car, cell phone numbers and accommodation during the competition. The recce cars will be checked when collecting recce materials in front of Rally HQ and also during recce.
- **7.3.** Cash penalties for violating recce regulations must be paid by 15.00 on July 16.
- 7.4. Recce cars tyres must comply with Estonian Traffic Law regulations, with following restrictions:
- using the retreaded tyres is forbidden
- tyres with markings "sport" and/or "rally" are forbidden
- removing the markings from the tyres is forbidden

8. RUNNING OF THE RALLY

- **8.1.** The competition cars have to arrive at the pre-start area on Centre Square in Otepää minimum 15 minutes before their own start in order to line up.
- 8.2. All competitors will start at 1-minute intervals.
- 8.3. The competitors will receive new time cards in the following Time Controls: TC 0, TC 3C, TC 6A.
- 8.4. Crews may check in early without incurring a penalty at the following Time Control: TC 3B.
- 8.7. Parc Fermé rules are applied at the end of Day 1.
- **8.8. Regroupings.** During the rally there will be regroupings.
- **8.8.1.** The start order for Day 2 shall be based on the classification at the finish of the final special stage of the previous Day. Organizer has the right to make changes to the start order.
- **8.9. Retirement.** Retired crew must immediately inform Rally HQ (phone +372 76 69 511) of their retirement reasons, fill out the retirement form (found on the final pages of Road Book), submit the form to marshals or the road-opening car and remove competition number form the car.
- **8.10.** Servicing. The service space reserved in the Service Park for each competition car is 6x8 m (40 m²). Competitors may purchase additional service space with the price of 50 EEK/m². In service park, all crews are obliged to have a liquid-proof tarp of minimum 3x5 m under competition cars.

One service vehicle per each competing car is permitted to Service Park. The vehicle must be clearly identified by a "Service" sticker issued by the organiser and affixed on the windshield. Recce cars are not permitted to Service Park.

Competitors who fail to comply with Service Park rules are subject to a cash penalty of 1000 EEK per each infringement.

8.11. Refuelling. Refuelling is permitted in Refuel Zones. The additional refuelling points on the route are marked in Road Book.

9. PENALTIES

9.1. Penalties for any breach of the FIA International Sporting Code (and its appendices), the EASU National Sporting Regulations, the General Prescriptions of Estonian Rally Championship and Estonian Rally Cup and the Supplementary Regulations will be imposed by the Stewards, the organiser and the EASU.

10. CLASSIFICATION

10.1. The classification will be published on the ONB by classes and groups.


11. PRIZES
