1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 PREAMBLE

The rally will be run in compliance with FIA International Sporting Code, Estonian Rally General Prescriptions (ERGP), Terminal Oil Estonian Rally Championship Regulations (EC), these Supplementary Regulations and their Appendices. Competition will be run under the national traffic laws or if these Supplementary Regulations are stipulating otherwise, the above-mentioned rules and guidelines apply.

Changes to the Supplementary Regulations will be announced to all crews by numbered and dated bulletins issued by the Organiser or the Stewards.

FIA International Sporting Code is published on <u>www.fia.com</u>. The Estonian Rally General Prescriptions, Estonian Rally Championship Regulations and Technical Regulations and their Appendices are published on <u>https://uus.autosport.ee</u> and Estonian Rally Championship Sportity channel (password: RallyEST).

The Supplementary Regulations are published in Estonian and English. In case of different interpretations, the Estonian version applies.

4 COMPETITORS

4.1 CLOSING TIME OF ENTRIES

The registration of the competitors ends on Monday, 24th April 2023 at 21:00.

4.2 ENTRY PROCEDURE

- The Competitors must register and fill in the electronical entry form published on the 7th April 2023 on the Organiser's website: <u>https://raplaralli.ee/en/voistlejale/registration/</u> and submit the duly completed entry form before the closing time of entries. A correct and working e-mail address is mandatory!
- Entries must be submitted in accordance with the EC Art. 21 23 and the FIA International Sporting Code Art. 3.8 3.14.
- An entry application will be accepted only after the payment of the total entry fee.

Crews or their representative are signing the entry form during the Administrative Checks. Crews must present their valid competitor's licence. The change of competitor is allowed until the closing time of entries. A change of competitor is permitted up to the close of entries. Only the competitor entered in the event will be allowed to make this request.

By signing the entry form, the Competitor allows to publish the information mentioned in this entry application in the media.

According to the International Sporting Code Art. 3.8.1 an entry compels the competitor to take part in the Competition in which they have been accepted to run, except in case of duly established *Force Majeure*. A Competitor who has submitted the entry application but is not able to participate in the rally, must inform the Organizer in written format latest by Monday, 1st May, 2023. The non-notification will be reported to the Stewards for the application of penalties.









4.3 NUMBER OF COMPETITORS ACCEPTED AND ELIGIBLE CLASSES

4.3.1 Number of the Competitors

The maximum number of entries is 100. The Clerk of the Course may increase the number of cars permitted to start. Upon reaching the specified number of entries, the Organiser reserves the sole right to decide which entries will be accepted.

4.4 ENTRY FEES

Competitors who refuse to carry Organiser's optional advertising (see Appendix 4) must pay doubled amount of the entry fee. Advertising on the rally plate and starting numbers is compulsory and cannot be refused. Reconnaissance only up to 18 years old juniors according to ERC championship regulations Art. 7.3. The entry fee includes national taxes.

The entry fee may also be paid in cash at the Rally HQ during the Administrative Checks. Entry will be accepted only after receipt of the total amount of the entry fee.

4.7 REFUNDS

The entry fee will be refunded in full only:

- In case of the rally not taking place due to the fault of the Organiser;
- To candidates whose entry has not been accepted.

The Organiser may partially refund entry fees:

- In case the rally does not take place due to Force Majeure – 75% refund;

The Organiser may partially refund entry fees if a competitor cannot take part in the event due to a duly proved case of *Force Majeure*.

5 INSURANCE

5.1 INSURANCE COVER FOR THE ORGANISER

5.1.1 Organiser's liability insurance

EASU visa includes liability insurance covering damage caused to a third party during the competition up to 500.000 EUR.

Deductible is 1 000 EUR. Insurer: AB "Lietuvos draudimas" Estonian branch Insurance period: 01.02.2022 kuni 31.01.2023 Policy No: 4234391811

5.1.2 Damage caused to a third party

A part of the insurance with AB "Lietuvos Draudimas", policy No 4234391811 is coverage for damages caused to a third party. However, damages caused by drivers among themselves are not covered by this contract. During the competition, the Estonian Traffic Insurance Act applies outside of special stages.









5.2 INTERNATIONAL GREEN CARD

All crews must hand in a compulsory motor vehicle insurance policy or International Green Card for their car at the pre-rally Scrutineering. Without these cards, the crew won't be permitted to start.

5.3 INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR COMPETITORS AND CREWS

All the drivers and co-drivers are obliged to arrange their own accident insurance. The proof should be documented on request at the Administrative Checks. By signing the entry form, the competitors and/or drivers relinquish any claims to compensations of any kind which might result due to incidents. The relinquishment is applied to FIA, ASN, and the Organiser, officials and other competitors and/or drivers.

5.4 DAMAGE REPORTING

The crews are obliged to notify the Organiser by email (<u>hq@raplaralli.ee</u>) about any damage caused on the track by their car by the end of event the latest. Violation of this duty will cause the competitor and involved crew to be summoned to a Rally Commission of the EASU.

5.5 INSURANCE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS

Auxiliary vehicles, reconnaissance cars and vehicles with special plates issued by the Organiser, as well as vehicles with the markings of Organiser's officials, are not covered by the provided rally insurance (except for insured Organiser's cars) and those are always going on their own responsibility.

5.6 DAMAGE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS

The Organiser refuses from any liability for damage that has been caused by a participant due to unsportsmanlike behaviour regarding rally regulations and these Supplementary Regulations or the State Law. In case of a road traffic accident involving a service car, a reconnaissance car or an official's car with rally plates only car owner's third-person's liability insurance policies are valid.

6 IDENTIFICATION AND ADVERTISING

6.1 COMPETITION NUMBERS

Competition numbers, rally plate and the Organiser's advertising should be affixed on the rally car according to the Appendix 4 of these Supplementary Regulations prior to pre-start Scrutineering.

6.2 LOSS OR REMOVAL OF ADVERTISING / COMPETITION NUMBER

A crew will be penalised with refusal to start at the rally if Article 6.1 of these Supplementary Regulations will have been violated. If it is ascertained at any point during the rally that an advertisement or sticker supplied by the Organiser is missing from a car, then the crew shall be penalised with a fine of 100 EUR for each missing or modified advertisement or if the advertisement is not affixed according to Appendix 4 of the SR. Competitor must affix advertising and identifications on the car according to regulations.

6.3 COMPETITION NUMBERS AND RALLY PLATES

Competition numbers and rally plates supplied by the Organiser must appear on both front doors of the car during the whole rally according to the Art, 27 of Estonian Rally General Prescriptions. If it is ascertained at any time during the rally that:

- a competition number or one rally plate is missing, this will be penalised by 300 EUR;

- both competition numbers or both rally plates are missing, this will be reported to the Stewards.









7 TYRES

7.1 ELIGIBLE TYRES DURING THE EVENT

The number of tyres for the competition is not limited. All tyres used during the rally must be commercially available and must comply with Estonian Rally General Prescriptions Standards. Any infringement to this rule will be reported to the Stewards. **Only gravel tires are allowed. Using of tarmac and lamellar tires is not allowed!**

7.2 PERMITTED WHEELS

The number of wheels is not limited. The use of wheels larger than 15 "is prohibited (except in classification class EMV 9).

7.3 TYRES USED FOR RECCONNAISSANCE

Tyres used for reconnaissance must be in conformity with Estonian Traffic Act. Sports tyres, racing tyres and studded tyres are prohibited. Any infringements will be reported to the Stewards and will result in penalty up to disgualification from the competition.

8 FUEL

8.1 FUEL RESTRICTIONS

Fuel must comply with FIA specifications (J 252 Art 9). Bioethanol E85 is allowed only in national E2WD and 4WD classes. Rally cars must be marked with blue E85 sticker.

8.2 REFUELLING

Refuelling is permitted only in the Refuelling Zone and remote refuelling zones designated by the Organiser in the Road Book. Passing through all the remote refuelling zones is not obligatory. Only actions inside a Refuelling Zone directly involved in the refuelling of the competing vehicle are permitted. Any other activity performed with the rally car is prohibited (Parc Fermé rules apply).

8.3 REFUELLING PROCEDURE

During refuelling a liquid proof mat must be used.

During refuelling, only crew members and support staff (up to 2 people per car) are responsible for fire safety. In order to access the refuelling zone, all personnel involved in refuelling operations must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves and a balaclava.

Competitors must be out of the race car during refuelling, in addition, it is forbidden to use a mobile phone during refuelling (including taking photos and videos).

Violation of the refuelling rules will result in a fine of EUR 100 for each mistake.

9 RECONNAISSANCE

9.1 RECONNAISSANCE REGISTRATION

Registration of reconnaissance cars is mandatory, the registration link can be found at <u>broneerimine.autosport.ee/recce</u> and must be filled in before the start of the Administrative Checks, no later than Wednesday, October 05 at 18:00. During the reconnaissance the registered reconnaissance car will be checked.









If during the reconnaissance the team changes the reconnaissance car for any reason, it must inform the secretary of the competition (phone: +372 5560 9882) and provide new information about the reconnaissance car.

The crew will receive identification for their car (2 number stickers). The number stickers must be affixed on the windscreen and the right rear side window during reconnaissance at all times. If, for any reason the crew is forced to replace the reconnaissance car during the reconnaissance, the HQ must be informed about the details of the new reconnaissance car.

9.2 GPS SAFETY TRACKING SYSTEM

The Organiser will provide each crew with a GPS safety tracking system. The device will be handed out at the Administrative Checks, and it must be used in the reconnaissance car during reconnaissance and in the rally car. Competitors must install the GPS-device in the reconnaissance car before the start of reconnaissance for speed monitoring and security purposes. More information about installation is provided upon receipt of the device. If the GPS-tracking-system is not used, it will be considered a breach of the reconnaissance regulations. The progress of the reconnaissance will be monitored via the GPS system by the Estonian Police together with rally officials. Evaluation of the GPS data is within the competence of Clerk of the Course. If it will be observed that the reconnaissance vehicle is not equipped with a working tracking system, the crew will be penalized according to the Stewards decision.

9.3 RECONNAISSANCE TIME SCHEDULE

Reconnaissance Time Schedule can be found in Appendix 2.

9.4 RECONNAISSANCE RULES

9.4.1 Reconnaissance

The crews are obliged to follow all reconnaissance rules specified in the Estonian Rally General Prescriptions, Terminal Oil Estonian Rally Championship 2023 Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations. Reconnaissance will be organised in compliance with Art. 35. of the ERGP and only series production cars conforming to art. 35.1.2. of FIA RRSR may be used. The car may be painted in multiple colours.

Anti-cutting devices will be used to avoid cutting. These devices will be in place or marked on track before the reconnaissance.

9.4.2 Speed limit

The maximum speed set for reconnaissance at the Special Stages is 80 km/h, unless a lower speed limit is indicated by traffic signs (50 km/h or 30 km/h) marked in the Road Book or additional speed limiting signs placed by the Organiser. Breaking the rules and exceeding the speed limits on public roads will also be fixed and fined by the Estonian Police according to Estonian Traffic Act.

9.4.3 Direction

Each crew may drive the special stages only in the direction of the rally. The crews must always enter the special stages through the start control and leave the special stages through the stop control.

9.4.4 *Restriction of reconnaissance*

Drivers, competitors, and their representatives are strictly forbidden to visit any road which is or might be used as a Special Stage after publishing of Supplementary Regulations. Failure to respect this rule shall result in the driver being reported to the Stewards.

9.4.5 Number of passages

Recce is permitted maximum 2 passages on each Special Stage. Special Stages run twice are considered to be one Special Stage. Drivers under the age of 18 are allowed 3 passages on each Special Stage.









9.4.6 Number of persons on board

During each passage through a Special Stage, a maximum of 2 persons (the crew) are permitted in the car.

9.4.7 Speeding

Speeding will be penalized by Clerk of the Course according to Art. 34.3.4* of ERGP as follows – per km per hour over the speed limit: all drivers 25 EUR.

9.4.8 Radar detection equipment

The fitting or carrying of radar detection equipment during reconnaissance is not permitted.

9.4.9 Penalties for violating reconnaissance rules

The violating the reconnaissance rules may be penalised by the Clerk of the Course or Stewards with a fine or refusal to start.

10 ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

Mandatory pre-registration for the Administrative Checks will be published on the webpage <u>www.broneerimine.autosport.ee</u> from Wednesday, 26th April, 2023 at 19:00 until Monday, 1st May, 2023 at 21:00.

The detailed Schedule for Administrative Checks will be published on the website <u>www.broneerimine.autosport.ee/en</u> and Sportity application on Tuesday, 2nd May, 2023, at 16:00.

The following documents must be presented at the Administrative Checks:

- Valid competitor's license;
- Valid driver's and co-driver's competition licenses;
- Valid driver's and co-driver's passport or ID card (mandatory for all foreign competitors);
- Valid driver's and co-driver's driving licenses;
- ASN authorisation (mandatory for all foreign competitors);
- Valid personal accident insurance (for non-EU drivers);
- Payment proof for the entry fee;
- Contact phone number;

Details concerning the co-driver can be specified until the end of the Administrative Checks.

The competitors must confirm their preferred Scrutineering time on the website <u>www.broneerimine.autosport.ee</u> starting from Wednesday, 26th April, 2023 at 19:00 until Monday, 1st May, 2023 at 21:00.

The detailed schedule for pre-rally Scrutineering will be published on the website <u>www.raplaralli.ee/en</u> and Sportity app on Tuesday, 2nd May, 2023 at 16:00 by Bulletin. Any competitor taking part in the rally, or their representative must arrive at the Scrutineering and present the car in accordance with the schedule to be issued in a Bulletin.

11.1.1 Documents to be presented at Scrutineering

- Vehicle's registration document;
- Vehicle's traffic insurance Policy or Green Card;
- Vehicle's ASN technical passport and homologation books with extensions for cars of groups A, R and N;
- Safety equipment declaration can be downloaded from Sportity application from ERC channel (password: RallyEST) or available for download at <u>www.uus.autosport.ee</u>).

11.1.2 Technical card

The technical card of the car will be deposited at the scrutineering and will be returned in Parc Fermé at the end of the rally. The card is kept by the scrutineers. A competitor who retires and will not present the car to the scrutineers (Estonian Rally General Prescriptions Art. 53.3.7^{1*}) concerning the display of the car will receive their technical card from the ASN after specifying the circumstances of the retirement and imposing a possible penalty. No duplicate card will be issued to them.

11.2 MUD FLAPS

Transversal mud flaps are mandatory and must comply with Appendix J Article 252.7.7.

11.3 WINDOWS

The use of silver or tinted films is allowed only on rear side windows and rear window and must comply with Appendix J Article 253.11.1.1.

11.4 SAFETY EQUIPMENT OF CREWS

Safety equipment of crews must comply with FIA regulations. Additional exemptions resulting from technical regulations are allowed in EMV5 to EMV9 classes.

11.5 NOISE LEVEL

The maximum noise level permitted is 103 dBA. Cars not complying with this rule will not be allowed to start. The noise will be measured with a sonometer set to "A" and "SLOW", placed at an angle of 45 degrees and at the distance of 50 cm from the exhaust outlet, with the car's engine running at 3500 rpm.

11.6 MARKING AND SEALING

Marking of turbochargers will be done during the Scrutineering.

11.7 CAR LIGHTNING

On road sections cars are allowed to use only the originally fitted headlamps with E-homologation. Headlamps without homologation must not be used during road sections. Complying with this provision will be checked by judges of fact. Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards.

11.8 NATIONAL REGULATIONS

Competing vehicles must be equipped with A3 size SOS/OK sign, first aid kit, a reflective triangle, and a reflective vest.









12 OTHER PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS

12.1 SHAKEDOWN

No shakedown stage will be held.

12.2 START PROCEDURE AND ORDER

12.2.1 Start of the rally

Rally start is on Friday, 5th May, 2023 at 17:10 from TC0 (Service Park). Start interval will be 1 minute for all the cars on both days. Starting order will be published on the website www.raplaralli.ee/en and Sportity app.

12.2.2 Start procedure for special stages:

The Time Card shall be handed to the crew during the last minute before start. The electronic start procedure shall be clearly visible to the crew from the start line.

- 30 seconds before the start 1st blue light switches on
- 15 seconds before the start 2nd blue light switches on
- 10 seconds before the start 3rd blue light switches on
- 5 seconds before the start 1st red light switches on
- 4 seconds before the start 2nd red light switches on
- 3 seconds before the start 3rd red light switches on
- 2 seconds before the start 4th red light switches on
- 1 second before the start 5th red light switches on
- Start all red lights switch off

A false start will be registered 50cm ahead of starting line and blue lights start blinking.

12.3 FINISH PROCEDURE

The competitive part of the rally ends with entering the TC 12A.

After podium crews are obliged to drive straight to the Parc Fermé. The Parc Fermé regulations will be in force until the opening of Parc Fermé, after that the competitors are obliged to remove their cars from the Parc Fermé. All infringements will be reported to the Stewards.

12.4 RETIREMENT PROCEDURE

If a crew retires, they must indicate the reason of retirement to the form in Road Book and return it with the Timecard to the closing car "Green Light" which is equipped with blinking green signal lights and follows the last competitor. In a case of an accident or technical failure at the Special Stage when the competing vehicle stays on the road or less than 3 m from the road the drivers must warn other competitors by placing the reflective triangle not less than 50m from the accident place in a visible place on the same side of the road where the car is located. **Retired crew must immediately inform Rally HQ (phone +372 5333 5564) of their retirement reasons.**

12.5 RESTART

Any crew which has failed to complete Leg 1 can re-start the rally from the start of Leg 2.

The Competitor must inform their intention to the Clerk of the Course (communication through the Competitor's Relations Officer) at least one hour prior to the publication of the start list of Leg 2. For all crews which re-start a time penalty of 5 minutes will be applied for every stage missed. *This time penalty will be added to the fastest time*









of the drivers' class for each missed stage or if it's not available, then the best time of the next slowest class. Should the retirement occur after the last special stage before the overnight regroup, time penalty of 5 minutes will be added to the time of their last special stage.

The car may be repaired at the competitor's discretion, but the car must retain its original body shell and engine block as marked at pre-rally scrutineering. The car must report to Service Park their service boxes for rescrutineering on Saturday, 6th May, 2023 at 07:30-08:00. The Crew or the Competitor must be present at the rescrutineering.

According to the EC Art. 9.5.2, crews retired on Leg 2 may use the restart also from the following sections, provided that this is accepted by the Clerk of the Course and the scrutineers. The crew restarting in the middle of the day, is not entitled for Championship points. The Competitor intending to restart during Leg 2 must inform their intention to the Clerk of the Course (communication through the Competitor's Relations Officer) as soon as possible. The final decision is made by the Clerk of the Course after the approval by the Stewards.

12.7 REGROUP

- **12.7.1** Starting intervals will be corrected resulting from retirements and/or late arrivals before entering Services A, B, C and F.
- **12.7.2** The start order for Leg 2 shall be based on the unofficial classification at the finish of the first section of the stages. Organiser may make changes due to safety reasons.
- **12.7.3** The first 10 cars in the unofficial classification will start to Leg 2 in reversed order according to their classification. Early check-in allowed to TC3A ja TC14.

12.8 PERMITTED EARLY CHECK-IN

12.8.1 Early check-in is allowed at TC 4B (Service B OUT), TC 4C (Parc Fermé IN) and TC 13 (Park Fermé IN).

12.9 GPS SAFETY TRACKING SYSTEM

All competitors must make provision in their cars for the installation of the Safety Tracking System. All further details will be given together with the device. Competitor is responsible for installation of the device and fastening the sticker.

Organiser's representatives will check proper installation of the device on Friday, 5th May 2023 starting from 17:10 in TC0. Competition cars not equipped with the GPS monitoring device will not be allowed to start. Any attempt to tamper with, to manipulate or to interfere with the tracking device fitted to the competition car or any device that hinders the tracking recording by external interference will be reported to the Stewards who may impose a penalty up to disqualification. The GPS-tracking-system must be returned correctly after TC13 or after retirement to the Administrative Checks at HQ.

12.10 PRINCIPLES ON SECURITY AND TRACKING

Security and tracking devices are connected to a monitoring centre that stores all data received. All data is also stored on the device itself. The device has a self-contained power supply that operates throughout the rally. The device has "SOS" and "OK" buttons. Each device has a unique serial number that is assigned to each crew. During the event the Rally HQ will monitor the location and speed of each crew.

12.11 "SOS" AND "OK" SIGNALLING PRINCIPLES

By pressing the "SOS" button a crew reports an accident and requests immediate assistance. Also "SOS" sign" has to be shown to following competing cars. In case of an accident or technical problems at a Special Stage, by pressing the "OK" button a crew informs of stopping for more than 30 seconds and that immediate assistance is not required (even if a crew is trying to continue the rally). Attention! In case of stopping at SS, the device automatically sends an "SOS" signal to the centre. If no assistance is required, the crew must press the "OK" button within 30 seconds to remove the "SOS" signal sent by the system. The crew's mobile phone must be switched on (or turned on within 60 seconds), so that the Race Control can reach the crew.

Incorrect "SOS" and "OK" signal transmission will be penalised.

In the case of an accident where urgent medical attention is required, when possible, the red "SOS" sign should immediately be displayed to the following cars attempting to assist (General Prescriptions Art 53.3.1.)

12.12 ENTRANCE TO THE REGROUP AREA

GPS tracking officers are allowed to enter the regrouping area and Parc Fermé in order to maintain or repair the GPS tracking systems installed in the rally cars. They must be accompanied by scrutineers and team representatives (driver, co-driver or competitor).









12.13 SERVICE PROCEDURES

Only Service cars (SERVICE) are allowed to enter Service Park. Recce vehicles are not allowed to enter the Service Park. Restrictions on servicing, refuelling, or changing of mechanical parts are listed in FIA RRSR and these comply with Art. 56, 57, 58 and 61 of Estonian Rally General Prescriptions 2022. Leaving the Service Park with a rally car between two legs is forbidden!

12.13.1 Layout of Service Park

Each registered team is allocated a 8x9 m (72 m²) service area, privateers 6x8 m (48 m²). It is possible to get more Service Area for 8 EUR/ m² until 1st May 2023 at 12:00. For additional service area requests, please send an e-mail to *hq@raplaralli.ee*.

12.13.2 Speed limit in Service Park

Maximum speed in the Service Park may not exceed 15 km/h. Speeding will result in a penalty applied by the Clerk of the Course according to Art. 57.4 of Estonian Rally General Prescriptions 2023.

12.13.3 Behaviour in the Service Park

A liquid-proof tarp of at least 3x5 meters must be used under the rally car while servicing In Service Park. Only one service vehicle per each rally car is allowed to enter Service Park. The vehicle must be clearly identified by a "Service" plate issued by the Organiser and affixed on the upper part of the front windscreen. Recce cars are not permitted to enter the Service Park.

For all the cars that are not allowed to park in the Service Park, are allowed to park in the public parking areas following the public parking rules.

Damages (nails, screws, and other fittings) to the surface of the Service Park are forbidden. The crew is responsible for damages to their service zone and must avoid causing them. Refuelling is permitted only in refuelling areas. Two fire extinguishers minimum 6kg must be present at each service zone. It is strictly forbidden to use open fire at the service zone (charcoal grill, firewood, etc.). After the rally the service zone must be handed over in tidy condition. Crews are responsible for the removal of their waste and sewage.

12.14 OBSTACLES

Due to safety reasons, barriers will be positioned on the rally route to reduce speed of rally cars. Judges of fact will monitor the right passage of barriers. The list of judges of fact will be published on the Official Notice Board in compliance with ISC Art. 11.16.7.

12.15 OFFICIAL TIME USED DURING THE RALLY

Official time throughout the rally is the one of GPS, timezone CET +1.

All teams required to complete a final scrutineering must immediately follow the instructions of the officials in charge, even if this means not passing one or more Time Control Points (TC). The final scrutineering must be prepared for the submission of the necessary certificates. The representative of the competitor and the mechanics with the necessary tools must be represented at the final scrutineering.

15.2 PROTEST DEPOSIT

Procedure for submitting protests in accordance with Art 13 of the FIA Sporting Code and Art 65 of the ERCG. The protest fee must be paid in cash to the Competition Secretary at the Rally HQ or by bank transfer to the current account of the Estonian Autosport Union: EE202200221002111381 (Swedbank, SWIFT: HABAEE2X).

Amount of the protest fee is 1000 EUR

If a protest is about another competitor's car, an additional deposit may be imposed by order of the Stewards according to the Technical Commission prescription.

15.3 APPEAL FEE
